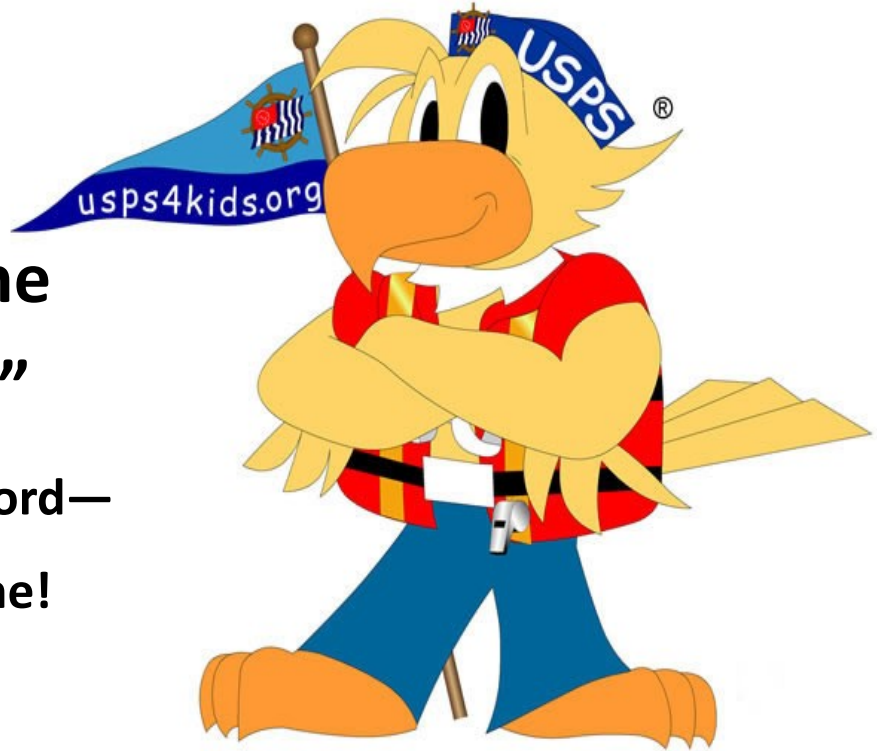

Posters should celebrate the diversity of the boating community in Charleston, from kayakers to offshore fishermen, from kids in jon boats to barge workers. Of course, posters should also reflect safe boating practices such as wearing personal flotation devices. Posters must be submitted by September 14, 2017 and must meet the requirements on the reverse of this sheet. Posters will be judged in three categories: ages 6-8, 9-11, and 12-14. “Age” is defined as the age of the child when the poster is turned in. Local first place winners receive \$20, second place winners \$15, and third place winners \$10. Local winners advance to the district competition and then to the national contest, with cash prizes at each level up to \$150. Best of luck to all our young artists!
